




Creating Safe Spaces Login Instructions

1. Start web browser and go to <https://creatingsafespaces.org.au/>
2. Move mouse cursor over "My Account" and click "My Account / Courses"





3. If you are already logged in, then the My Account / Courses page will appear (go to step 4). Otherwise, if you are not logged in, the login page will appear. Enter your login details under Username and Password and Click "Log in".

HINT: Your username is usually all the characters before the "@" symbol on your email address and your password is the password you created when you purchased the online module or when you first registered as a user. If you have forgotten your password you can reset your password by selecting "My Account" | "Lost Password" from the menu.
